**eMMA's Sourcing Module**, which went live in July 2019, is a centralized procurement tool that enables collaboration and enhances Solicitation transparency and efficiency throughout the State. Procurement Officers can manage their Solicitations through standardized processes:

- Define the internal team, key dates / schedule, etc.
- Communicate with the team and invited vendors through a centralized common tool
- Upload and distribute all documents related to solicitations
- Invite Vendors that are either already approved or potential vendors to participate
- Monitor vendor questions and document answers
- Evaluate vendor proposals
- Award vendor responses

### What's New with Release 1.2?



Release 1.2, which will be live in Fall 2021, will provide the following functionalities:

- 1. PO and Non-PO Vendor Setup & Registration
  - PO Vendor Set up Allows vetting and setup of vendors to which the State wishes to award a contract
  - B. **Non-PO Vendor Setup -** Allows setup of vendors who have not received a purchase order but still require payment based on an invoice
- 2. Vendor Maintenance Process
  - A. Vendor Initiated Change Request Allows vendors to self-serve and initiate change requests for vendor information including, for example, banking information for setup/maintenance in the Automated Clearing House (ACH) program
  - State Initiated Change Requests Allows State users to initiate change requests to maintain vendor records

This release will affect the vendor setup & maintenance processes of all state agencies. Impacted users include Vendors, Agency Vendor Coordinators, Agency Procurement Officers, Agency Accounts Payable, Comptroller GAD, and State Treasurer Office roles.

#### What will Happen in Release 2.0?

Release 2.0, which will focus on the requisitioning through payment processes, will kick off in Winter 2021.
